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Lake Redstone Protection District Continues Impactful Work Regarding Water Quality



In 2023, the Lake Redstone Protection District, a local taxpayer supported organization, continued its mission to maintain and improve water quality. Water quality is a complex topic. 2024 will be the third year in the implementation of a 10-year DNR-approved Lake Management Plan.

Some of the impactful things done in 2023 and/or planned for 2024 to carry out the Lake Management Plan are:

- Continue working with farmers, primarily via the "Producers of Lake Redstone Watershed" group led by Juneau County. Contrary to some perceptions, day-to-day runoff into the lake from farmer fields is quite low and less than ever before. This is per stream monitoring devices in place. However, because there has not been a large rain event since 2018, it is unclear how effective the new wide-spread soil retention practices will be in preventing major runoff during "gulley-washers".
- ❖ Continue educating and working with property owners to prevent tons of phosphorusbearing runoff from going into the lake. Many properties have grass running right up to the lake and/or don't have runoff prevention methods in place. There are now three programs that property owners can take advantage to help them identify and plan an improvement project and receive reimbursement for it.
- Continue identifying culverts, gulleys, and other inputs into the lake where LRPD can make or facilitate changes. The LRPD also maintains improvements made in previous years such as weirs (small dams to control water flow).
- Continue the 40-year history of monitoring water quality at various sites and depths in the lake i.e. measuring water clarity, phosphorus, dissolved oxygen and temperature.
- ❖ Implement the recently updated Aquatic Plant Management Plan to protect native plants in the lake, while controlling nuisance levels of non-native plants.
- Continue partnerships with a dozen organizations and stakeholders to improve water quality in Lake Redstone.


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Clubhouse Rental
